Peace, like war, is **waged**.

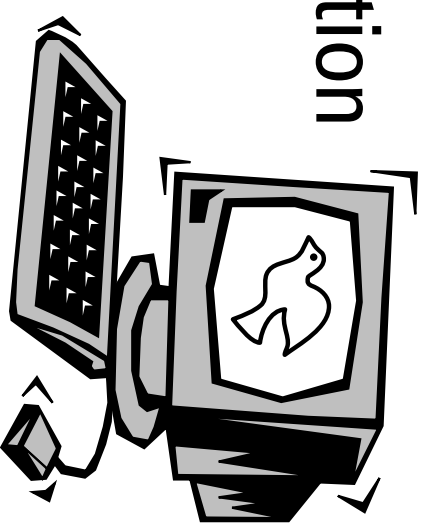
**But Christ has turned
